#### PART - (A)

The IQAC had chalked out plan of action for the academic year 2006-07 to make improvements in the performance of their institution for quality enhancement and sustenance. One meeting of Parent Teachers Association is held in the college every year in the beginning of the academic year. The parents extend their full co-operation and support by attending the programme in the college.

# 29) Health Services:

At the beginning of the academic year medical check-up is held for first year students of all the three faculties as per the university rules. Appointed doctors are invited for the purpose. Primary aid is given to students immediately when there is an emergency by the appointed doctor of the college. There are many cases where students are given First aid in the college.

# 30) Performances in Sports activities:

The overall performance of our institution in sports for the academic year 2006-07 was quite satisfactory:

- a) Six students stood winners in inter-collegiate boxing tournaments and further participated at All India Inter University competition held at Rohtak, Haryana.
- b) Our Basket-ball (men) team stood runners-up in Inter-collegiate tournament. Three students from it were selected for Inter-zonal and out of it one student was selected for All India Inter-University Competition at Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh.
- c) Our Foot-ball team reached the semi-finals and from it three students were selected for inter-zonal tournament and from the three students one was selected for inter-university tournament at Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.
- d) Our Volleyball team reached the semi-final and two students were selected for inter-zonal tournament and Inter university Ashvamedh tournament at Jalgaon.
- e) Abdul Hamid Ghulam Mustafa stood first at Power-lifting at inter-college tournament and third at inter zonal tournament.
- f) Rahul Jadhav stood second at Body Building competition at inter college and inter-zonal level.
- g) Mansur Zakir Hussein stood second in 4x100 mtrs relay race at inter college competition and was declared a winner in inters zonal tournaments.
