29) Health Services:

As per the university rules, Medical check-up is held for first year students of all the three faculties at the beginning of the academic year. Appointed doctors are invited for the purpose. When there is an emergency, Primary aid is given to the students immediately by the appointed doctors of the college.

30) Performances in Sports activities:

The overall performance of our institution in sports for the academic year 2010-11 was quite satisfactory.

- 1) Three students stood winners and six student's runners up at inter collegiate Boxing (M) competition. From these three students were selected for All India Inter University Boxing Tournament at Udaipur, Rajasthan.
- 2) Our Kabaddi (M) teams stood Winners at intercollegiate tournament, winners at inter zonal competition and from these two players further participated in inter university competition at Ajmer Rajasthan.
- 3) Our Handball (M) team stood Winners at intercollegiate tournament and four players are selected for Jalgaon zone team for inter zonal tournament at Shirpur.
- 4) Our Football (M) team stood third at intercollegiate tournament Jalgaon, three players are selected in Jalgaon zone team for inter zonal tournament at Dhule and stood winners and two players further participated in West Zone inter university Football competition at Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh.

- 5) Our Basketball (M) teams stood Runners-up at intercollegiate tournament at Jalgaon and two players were selected in Jalgaon zone team for inter zonal competition and stood runners up and one player further participated in inter university competition at Jodhpur, Rajasthan.
- 6) Parag Patil participated in All India inter university Softball competition at Guntur, Andhra Pradesh.
- 7) Parag Patil, Miss Sudha Wani and Miss Madhuri Rokade were declared first, second and third respectively at Fencing inter collegiate competition at Jalgaon and two players participated at All India Inter university Fencing tournament at Jammu.
